### **Arthur McPherson – Behind the badge**

Arthur gave an account of his working life where by he worked for the RAAF for 29 years as air traffic controller. He later joined ESSO Australia working in their air traffic department at the Longford heliport. Arthur had to become acclimatised to

the pace of helicopters from the high speed of defence jet aircraft. In the early days, ESSO had a fleet of 12 helicopters but now they have a fleet of only 6 to cover more platforms. With this down size, there is a greater emphasis on aircraft maintenance to do more “work with less” (sounds familiar) Of recent times, Arthur completed 3 days time in the Fulham jail to become familiar with the life as an “in-mate”. The Fulham experience left Arthur “over the wall”

### **Guest Speaker- Brian Turner of St Paul’s, Anglican Cathedral, former Ambassadorial Scholar and now a member of the Sale Rotary Club.**

Brian outlined his 59 years of life to the club members. Brian felt that along the way, he would like to comment on the 5 truths that have become important to him (I have not included them in the report).

Brian is a son of a banker. He had his first spiritual experience at the Billy Graham crusade at the age of 15 years. Just after that occurred, he left school and become an apprentice carpenter. He finished his trade course to become Apprentice of the year in 1964. He left home and travelled to Wagga to set up life without the influence of his parents. He later won a Rotary Scholarship for study in the UK. He sailed to the UK on the SS Oriana in January 1967 for a year of study. He lived in Derby where he spoke on 40 occasions to clubs all over the UK.

Brian married an Aussie girl in the UK and had a round the world

honeymoon on Rotary. On the way he spoke to Rotarians in Amsterdam, Paris, Rome, Teheran, Singapore and Bangkok. He returned to work as a Quantitative Surveyor. His wife had 2 children and he considered entering politics but chose to set-up his own business with 2 mates and the father in law.

In 1974 he entered the Theological College in Canberra to train for the Anglican Priest hood. His mother died at 56 and he had a strained relationship with this father who was a good boxer. His fathers boxing prowess left a long lasting image to Brian.

Brian entered his first parish of Batlow where he joined Rotary and got fined for getting “involved in the spiritual world”. He had two years working as priest in the UK then moved back to Canberra where he got to know our Brian Norris. His marriage ended in failure and he moved back into building. He remarried and has a blended teenage family of 6 children. Living in Sale where he has a wonderful life with a disabled wife. Brian feels that Rotary is part of the rich tapestry that makes life so fulfilling and worthwhile and thanked us for the part we play as fellow Rotarians.
