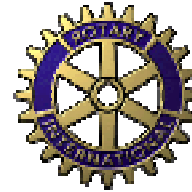

Polio Plus Progress Report

As of 21 April 2004, 784 cases of polio worldwide have been confirmed for 2003. 107 cases have been confirmed for 2004 including 74 in Nigeria, 8 in India, and 8 in Pakistan.

Progress has been made in encouraging immunization in northern Nigeria. During March NIDs, all states but Kano participated. Efforts continue to encourage Kano’s governmental and religious leaders to join the rest of the country in these important and historic immunization endeavors.

In further support of regional advocacy efforts, Past RI President Luis Giay traveled to Niger to present a Polio Eradication Champion Award to President Mamadou **Tandja** of Niger. President Tandja has been an outstanding supporter of immunization efforts.

When presenting the award, Rotary Foundation Trustee Luis Vicente Giay remarked that Tandja is helping eradication efforts by combating rumors and misinformation in both Niger and Nigeria about vaccine safety.

President Tandja has been very supportive of polio eradication activities. Most recently he traveled to Dan Issa, a Nigerian town about 7 km from the Northern Nigerian border to launch the first round of Polio NIDs. At the launch ceremony, he spoke in both French and also the Hausa language, spoken by the majority of inhabitants in this border area. He reassured the people that the vaccine was safe. He called on them to immunize their children and requested that they not obstruct the work of the vaccination teams. He then administered a few immunizations. He also held side meetings with local religious leaders including a visiting delegation from Katsina, Nigeria one of the states which had been opposed to immunization.

The March NIDs took place not only in Nigeria but in a number of west and central African countries including Benin, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, the Central African Republic, Chad, Ghana, and Togo which all synchronized their immunization activities. This assured

a more effective campaign which reached border populations and migrating ethnic groups. The campaigns targeted 63 million children.

PolioPlus Partners funding provided significant support to Cote d’Ivoire, Togo, Niger, and Benin Rotarians for their March efforts.
