Guest speaker- Greg Flynn CFA,

Guest speaker Greg indicated that he wished to discuss two main subjects that are very topical today.

1. Fire-fighting fleet strategy

Has 16000 appliances with a lifecycle of 20 years. Future needs are eventual changing and will impact on the CFA future.

Future needs?

- Community demographic change
- Brigade profile may change
- CFA service delivery

All of the above require an appliance strategic direction

One appliance development that is happening is that

- Tanker fleet changing from a 3 people seat tanker to a cabin type crew cabin with increased tanker capacity for both –fire fighting, and a retention tank for crew protection
- A Scania pumper retails at close to \$500,000 for urban firefighter. Sale brigade took delivery of one of these recently.

2. Communications system changes

There is a new telephone system that allows up to 24 parties to be connected at the same time- something not possible with an analogue system of old.

3. Emergency alerting System

Primary alerting system for the CFA, SES and Rural Ambulance

- 28,000 radio pagers are being planned for this project
- More than just alerting
- 7 yr contract with the State Government
- Integral to centralized call taking
- EAG service area virtually covers the whole state with 195 base stations
- Each base has a 24 k radius cover.
- The new system allows for greater speed and efficiency to notify CFAs
- In an emergency.
