It seems the imagination knows no limits when it comes to rehabilitation of offenders. Brendan Fitzgerald spoke briefly but interestingly about the latest theatrical production under his direction.

18 to 25 first offenders under Brendan's direction used their skills to create and perform a play based on 'The Tempest' before an audience of members of the community.

Brendan informed us that the focus of the project was towards breaking down the barriers which are confronted by prisoners when they are released from incarceration and are re-entering the community. Putting on the production is designed to demonstrate the skills of the prisoners and to give the prisoners self confidence in their own skills.

Feedback from the audience on the performance by the prisoners was planned to be given to the prisoners as another positive element in the process. Like all creative people Brendan was clearly extremely excited and energetic about the project and in particular the efforts of the prisoners in making their production happen.
